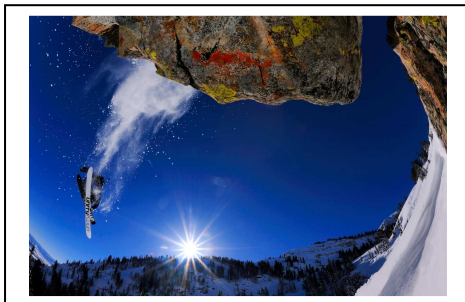


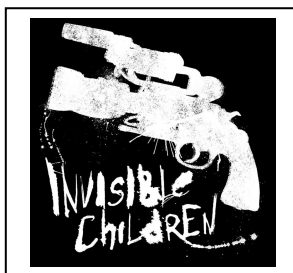

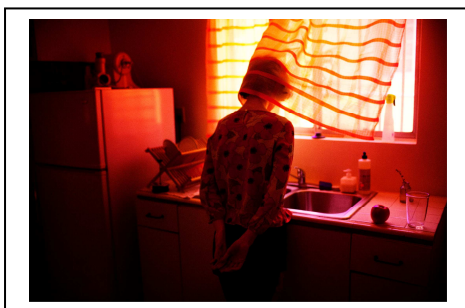
9/13 Lucas Gilman

He has shot covers for TIME, Newsweek, Fortune, The New York Times Sunday magazine and many others, as well as being an ongoing contributor for Sports Illustrated, National Geographic, and a staff photographer at LIFE. Joe was listed by American Photo as one of the 100 Most Important People in Photography. He has also been honored by Kodak-PDN Legends Online and is a Nikon Legend Behind the Lens, among many other awards. His "Faces of Ground Zero" raised more than \$2 million for the relief effort and is considered to be one of the most important artistic endeavors to come out of the 911 tragedy.
